### Minutes

Traditional Philately Commission Meeting in Seoul, South Korea on Sunday 10 August 2014

Agenda point 1.

The new chairman Lars Peter Svendsen welcomed all participants at the meeting and was happy so seeing so many people attending the meeting. A special welcome was given to the two F.I.P. Board members present, Bernard Beston and Peter McCann.

The chairman announced he had appointed Patricia Stilwell-Walker, USA as secretary of the commission until the next F.I.P. congress and vote to the bureau in 2016.

Agenda point 2.

Roll call showed 36 delegates and proxy voting privilege present. Six observers also present

Agenda point 3.

The minutes from Australia 2014 on 5 June 2013 was approved without comments.

The chairman presented all major events and achievements by the Traditional Philately Commission since the last congress in Jakarta 2012.

Some federations have not yet sent name and email address of their delegate to the commission and the chairman encourages the federations to do that. - A Commission meeting and Seminar was held in Melbourne at the Australia 2013 World Stamp Exhibition in May of 2013
- A Seminar and Workshop was held at BRASILIANA-2013 in November 2013

Further the Bureau had worked on

- Gathering traditional philately exhibit results
- Provided lists of FIP jurors accredited in the Traditional Class
- Discussion in the Bureau about use of Pre Philatelic material and Postal Stationeries in Traditional Philately (result presented in newsletters)
- Discussion in the Bureau about reprints and replicas
- Finally the Chairman announced that a new agreement with SPINK about sponsorship of the Traditional Philately Commission website had been signed by both parties.

Agenda point 4.

The Bureau will be working on the following items for the next two years.

- Continuing discussions of material allowable and publication of conclusions, if any via website and newsletter. The delegates were encouraged to come up with new discussion points to the Bureau.
- Obtaining translation for French and review of German translation for current SREVs and Guidelines
- Review of SREVs and Guidelines to determine if updates are required since they were written, input from delegates welcomed
- Make a brochure to promote Traditional Philately
