



Report for 2015

Commission meeting

The commission held a meeting in Singapore in connection with the Singapore 2015 International Exhibition. At that meeting it was announced that the SREV and Guidelines for exhibiting Traditional Philately Exhibit had been translated into French and also translated into German. The translations are available at the Traditional Philately Commission WEB-site. Updates of the list of delegates to the commission have been performed during the year, and the list seems now more complete than for the last many years.

At the commission meeting in Singapore during a mini seminar about judging "Importance" valuable discussion took place about how to evaluate the three sub criteria under importance namely

- A. How much of the key material of the chosen subject is present.
- B. The significance of the subject within the philately of the country area exhibited.
- C. The significance of the subject on a worldwide scale.

Point A seems often to be forgotten by Judges when judging Traditional Philately Exhibits.

The chairman ended the meting with a lecture about Importance vs. Rarity.

30 delegates and approx. 30 observes attended the meeting.

A new Commission meeting is already planned for New York 2016.

Rules and regulations

A new Checklist when judging has been issued. The checklist is not a replacement for the Guidelines but meant as a tool to check if you have considered everything when giving points to a given exhibit. It can also assist you when writing feedback to the exhibitor on where he has his strength and areas of improvement.

Newsletters

Newsletter no 5 was sent out in June 2015 and Newsletter no 6 was sent out in December 2015. They are sent out to 65 delegates, where we have email addresses and to all federations within FIP. Both newsletters were very well received by the delegates and federations.

WEB-page
